After watching our Virtual Courthouse Experience Tour with your class, we recommend viewing a <u>live courtroom hearing</u> or consider scheduling a <u>Classroom Visitor</u> from our list of volunteers.

Live courtroom hearings are streamed over <u>WebEx</u>. If you don't have WebEx on your computer, you may want to add it ahead of time or give yourself some extra time prior to joining with your class and the live hearing.

Internet Explorer is not supported on the Oregon Judicial Branch page. Use a different browser like Microsoft Edge, Chrome, or Safari.

You can view day-of and future hearing schedules on the <u>Multnomah County Live Hearings</u> page. It is worth noting that these schedules are subject to change. Other counties are working to adopt live streaming, please visit the <u>Live Proceedings</u> page for all Oregon counties and more information.

When joining the live stream you may need to enter your name and email address. You can use your school name and email address. Such as first name: Franklin, last name: Middle School and email address: franklin@a.com

We recommend viewing the live stream from your device and "sharing" your screen with your students, rather than each student logging in from their own devices in class.
